GRADING SYSTEM

The Italian grading scale runs from 0 to 30. Minimum score to pass an exam is 18; the maximum is 30 e lode (cum laude, “with distinction”). institutions allocate a standard value to courses, generally known as ECTS credits or CFU (Credito Formativo Universitario) in Italian. **1 LOCAL CREDIT (CFU) = 1 ECTS CREDIT**

COURSE SELECTION REQUIREMENTS

Incoming students nominated for the Department of ESOMAS:

- must select at least **51% of courses** (= credits, CFU) **from SME campus offerings (IMPORTANT: interdepartmental programs do not count as SME courses)**
- they may also choose courses from other Departments within the University of Turin, provided they obtain approval via email from the professor responsible for each selected course. This is a [list of Departments](#)

Incoming students nominated for the Department of Management can choose:

- **100% of their courses** from those offered at the **SAA campus**. For more information: exchange.saa@unito.it.
- OR
- they may follow the 51% credit rule of the ESOMAS Department.
