For new exchange partners, please submit a nomination form as attached by the email notification , then an automatic email will be sent to notify of further nomination details, regarding the nomination access.</li></ol>
<b>Applications</b>	<p>Nominees receive an automatic email notification each to be provided with the access to online application portal, where they complete an online application and submit supplementary documentation where necessary on the application portal:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Applicant's details (where applicable on the portal) ;</li><li>2. Uploading supplementary documentation including but not limited to: Passport photo page, transcript, language verification proof ( e.g. IELTS/TOEFL iBT / home school's recommendation attesting language skills, etc.)</li></ol>
<b>Deadlines</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Nomination Deadline for Fall Semester 2025: 15 May 2025</li><li>2. Application Deadline for Fall Semester 2025: 31 May 2025</li><li>3. Nomination Deadline for Spring Semester 2026: 30 October 2025</li><li>4. Application Deadline for Spring Semester 2026: 15 November 2024</li></ol>
<b>Academic Requirements</b>	Eligible exchange candidates are expected to demonstrate sufficient knowledge required to follow the modules across at least one of the fields across Economics/ Management / Social Sciences / Laws/ Engineering
<b>Language Requirements</b>	Eligible exchange candidates are expected to meet at least one of the following language requirements: IELTS 6.0/ TOEFL (iBT) 80 / HSK Level 3. Exchange partner institution may also issue written approval of their language proficiency, either in English or Chinese, if the nominated candidates have not achieved the above required scores.

## Admissions

<b>Timeline</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Admission decisions are normally made based on complete submission of individual exchange applications; late/incomplete applications will not be processed.</li> <li>2. For Fall 2025 exchange applications, admission decisions shall normally be notified by the end of June 2025, for Spring 2026 exchange applications, admission decision shall normally be notified by the end of December 2025.</li> <li>3. Once being confirmed to be accepted into the student exchange hosted by SUFE, our International Admissions Team shall aim to update accepted individuals with more pre-arrival practicalities, including housing and visa-supporting documentation etc.</li> </ol>
<b>Note</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Please be noted for exchange nominees currently holding Chinese nationality, or Hong Kong (China Mainland) /Macau (China Mainland) /Taiwan (China Mainland) identities, they shall neither be nominated nor apply through the above online portal.</li> <li>2. In these above cases as mentioned, our admission team shall aim to reach nominees individually by email, regarding separate application steps.</li> </ol>
