



- Off-Campus: between 1600 MAD 3000 MAD
  - → Anfa City: www.resu.ma/les-residences-universitaires-anfa-city/
  - → Bay Al Maarifa: https://baytalmaarifa.ma/
- Apartments : shared flat \* between 5000-12500MAD (for an apartment including electricity and water).
  - Accommodation recommendations are shared with students.
- Food : 2500-3500 MAD (250-350 USD/Euros approx.
- Public transportation : (23 USD/Euros approx.)
  - → Tramway: 8 MAD one way/ Monthly card (23 USD/Euros approx.) More details: https://www.casatramway.ma/tickets-tarifs/nos-offres
  - → Taxi: red local taxis (3 passengers max). Apps are also available: InDrive, Careem...

If your country is not on this list, then you should apply for a visa from the Moroccan consulate in your country.

If you are exempted from the visa and expect to stay in Morocco longer than 3 months, then you need to apply for an extension through the Moroccan authority's immigration office in your country before your arrival.
