

# nomination process & deadlines

Partner universities **nominate** their students **through the online nomination form in the CU InfoSheet**.

Students must be nominated within the respective nomination period:

1 March 2025 - 15 April 2025

nomination for winter semester or full academic year

1 August 2025 - 15 September 2025

nomination for summer semester

Nominations after the deadline may not be accepted due to capacity constraints. Please note that **nominations sent by email will not be processed**.





# **application**process & deadlines

**Application instructions will be e-mailed** to all nominated students along with the online application link.

All nominated students must **fill in the CU Online Application form** <u>here</u>.

## summer semester

15 October 2025	submit the CU Online Application

The documents below must be sent to documents.erasmus@fsv.cuni.cz by the respective deadline.

- 1 CU Online Application form + Learning Agreement (LA/OLA/DLA)
  - must be signed by the student, and signed and stamped by the home university coordinator
  - student can use the CU LA (page 3 of the CU Online Application), or can work with an LA/OLA/DLA provided by the home university

**!**∕⁵ only 1 LA is required by FSV UK

- 2 latest version of Transcipt of Grades
- 3 English level confirmation (B2 or higher, clearly stated)
  - official certificate: FCE, CAE, TOEFL, IELTS, etc.
  - confirmed by the home university

**FSV UK** has **5 institutes** and a Language Centre **offering courses** for exchange students **in English**.



# **courses for** incoming students

Not all courses provided at the CU Faculty of Social Sciences are open to incoming students. **Make sure you are applying the proper filters during your course search**.

# **how to search for courses** available to incoming students



Incoming students can attend **only courses available for incoming students**. The instructions on how to search for courses in SIS as an incoming exchange student are described **here**, including a video tutorial.

In the search engine, students are required to choose the *Faculty of Social Sciences* and the *class courses for incoming students*. Then they can narrow their search by applying filters such as *semester*, *language*, or *school* (for searching by FSV UK institutes).

# how to read the course codes

Every course at Charles University has a **unique code**. Course codes of courses provided by the CU Faculty of Social Sciences start with the letter **J-**, e.g., JEB111.

the **second letter** indicates the study field/area or the institute offering the course:

JE-  $\rightarrow$  economics JK-  $\rightarrow$  communication studies

JJ-  $\rightarrow$  journalism JT-  $\rightarrow$  international studies

**JS-** → sociology **JP-** → political sciences

**JL-**  $\rightarrow$  faculty language centre

the **third letter** indicates the study level:

**B** → bachelor level

 $\mathbf{M} \rightarrow \text{master level}$ 

**D** → doctoral level

→ **JEB111** is a **B**achelor course offered by the Institute of **E**conomic Studies.
