

RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP MOZ/001/2025, AT ISEG EVALUATION MINUTES

1. The notice was published in EURAXESS with the reference “ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE AWARD OF A RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP REFERENCE MOZ/001/ 2025 – AT ISEG”, to award a research scholarship to a master’s or doctorate student. The competition was open between 03/01/2025 and 5 pm (Lisbon time zone) on 16/01/2025.
2. The competition panel was made up of Henrique Pita Barros (President), Patrícia Justino and João Pereira dos Santos.
3. 3 applications were received within the deadline stipulated by the competition:
 - a. Amir Sokhandan;
 - b. Vasco Cambotas de Medeiros;
 - c. Daniel Missell.

An application was received after the deadline stipulated by the competition, and was for this reason disqualified:

- d. Rafael Queiroz Pinheiro.
4. Of the three applications accepted for the competition, the jury decided on the following curricular evaluation:
 - a. Amir Sokhandan: 10/100: the candidate does not demonstrate compliance with the criteria stipulated in the competition as necessary to carry out the work. Namely: i) does not demonstrate verbal and written proficiency in the Portuguese language; ii) does not demonstrate experience in fieldwork in the global south, particularly Mozambique and Cabo Delgado; iii) does not demonstrate knowledge of econometric analysis using stata.
 - b. Vasco Cambotas de Medeiros: 75/100.
 - c. Daniel Missell: 85/100.
5. Following the terms stipulated by the competition, candidates with a CV evaluation above 70/100 were invited for an interview. The two candidates admitted to the interview obtained the following classifications:
 - a. Vasco Cambotas de Medeiros: 50/100.
 - b. Daniel Missell: 80/100.
6. The motivation letters of candidates admitted to the interview obtained the following classifications:
 - a. Vasco Cambotas de Medeiros: 70/100
 - b. Daniel Missell: 100/100

7. Taking into account points 4., 5. and 6., and using the calculation formula stipulated by the competition, the final classifications of the two candidates admitted to the interview are:
 - a. Vasco Cambotas de Medeiros: 69.5 points.
 - b. Daniel Missell: 85.5 points.

8. On January 23, 2025, the jury decided that, given the terms of the competition and classification of the different evaluation components, and considering the curricular suitability, motivation, previous experience, namely field work in Cabo Delgado and current attendance at a doctorate in development studies, the scholarship subject of this competition must be awarded to the candidate Daniel Missell.
