HEALTH INSURANCE

All students going abroad are required to purchase or subscribe to health. Partner universities may also require students to purchase the university's health plan.

ISEG recommends citizens of EU/EEA countries or Switzerland should register for a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) in their home country before coming to France. This card gives students the right to medical care at the same cost as France.



ACCOMMODATION & HOUSING

(Students are responsible for finding their own accommodation but may get support from the host institution)

Be careful, housing scams do happen sometimes. Check everything carefully before transferring any large sums of money abroad. Students are responsible for finding their own accommodation.

VISA & IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS

European Students

Passport or identity card valid until 6 months after the end of the academic stay.

EU/EEA Citizens

Are allowed to stay in France without a residence permit. It is recommended to register at the Portuguese Consulate of the country that will host you.

Non-EU/EEA Citizens

Must have been granted a student residence before entering to one of the EM Normandie's campuses. You should apply for your permit or at the nearest embassy or consulate, of the country that will host you, 3-5 months before departure.

A tourist visa is not sufficient as it is only valid for three months.
