With the support of ADVANCE, ISEG's Strategy and Marketing community, hosted one of the most important academic conferences in the field from the 25th to the 27th September 2024: the 15th edition of the EMAC - European Marketing Academy Regional Conference. The conference was attended by researchers from more than 20 countries and set a record for the number of scientific papers submitted and participants, as well as for awarding the Best Scientific Paper of the Conference prize for the first time.

Over these three days, the ISEGian Strategy and Marketing community, comprising members of faculty, researchers, and students from the Masters in Marketing and the PhD in Management, met to debate the role of Marketing as a mechanism for proposing solutions and creating value for companies and society as a whole, under the theme of 'Exploring the Future of Marketing: Reshaping Marketing's Role in Society'.

The conference started with two keynote speakers: Adilson Borges, Dean and Executive Director of the Rennes School of Business, and Sankar Sen, Professor of Marketing at Baruch College, City University of New York. Adilson addressed the topic of 'Academics are from Mars, Practitioners are from Venus: Building Bridges between Academia and Industry to Create Value for Organisations and Society', while Sankar discussed morality in Marketing in his presentation entitled 'Wherefore Marketplace Morality?' The Tuna Académica musical ensemble provided a special moment of entertainment for the participants.

The conference participants also had the opportunity to take part in two workshops. The first, led by Giampaolo Viglia, Professor at the University of Portsmouth, focused on how to design a social science experiment. The second, moderated by Nathalie Spielmann, Professor of Marketing and Director of the MSc in Wine & Gastronomy of NEOMA Business School, addressed the strategic positioning of wine brands in the Portuguese market and included a wine tasting session.

The 30 scientific paper discussion sessions covered current and disruptive topics related to strategic and business marketing, brand management, consumer behaviour, communication and advertising, retail and ecommerce, digital marketing and social networks, Metaverse and AI, sustainability, and international marketing, among others.

The conference also included two sessions of meetings with editors from 10 international scientific journals in the field of marketing, including the Journal of the Academy of Marketing Science, the Journal of Consumer Psychology, and the International Journal of Research in Marketing, the latter being listed in the Financial Times ranking and categorised as Tier 4 in the ABS list. ISEG's scientific Management journal, the European Journal of Management Studies, was also represented during one of the Meeting with Editors sessions, represented by its Editor-in-Chief and colleague, Tiago Cardão-Pito.

The conference adopted an innovative social initiative, whereby the cost of the Gala Dinner for participants who were unable to attend was donated to the Casa de Proteção e de Amparo Santo António, a Private Social Solidarity Institution located in the local parish of Estrela, which supports teenage mothers and their children.
